Here are some pictures of the people you will see in the show.

This is Harriet



Harriet is a musician. She plays an instrument called a Marimba which looks like this



Harriet plays the Marimba with sticks that look like this.



This performer is called Hobbit



Hobbit is an acrobat, which means she uses her body to make shapes.



Hobbit makes shapes with her body like this

This is Jake



Jake is a circus performer, which means he uses his body to do tricks. Here he is making a purple butterfly fly, you'll see this in the show.



He also uses his body to make shapes like this

This is Hollie, Hollie looks after the set – which is everything you see onstage.



You will sit on cushions that look like these to watch the show.





There are screens around the performance area and behind where you'll be sitting that look like this.



The screens will flip around like this.



And on the other side they are different colours.



There will also be 4 different boxes coming on and off stage over the course of the show. The main boxes you will see are a pink box and a blue box.

At the end of the show some long pieces of coloured fabric are thrown over the top of the screens. They look like this. They will be used to make a roof, like the roof of a circus tent.



Here is a picture of the pattern that will be on the floor.



### **What Happens at the End**

At the end of the performance, the audience clap their hands to show that they have enjoyed the performance.

You can clap your hands too, if you would like to. If the clapping is too loud you can cover your ears.

You can then stay and play with the performers and the set, but if you don't want to stay you can go home after the end of the show.
